

Undergraduate Minor - Applied Microeconomics

Required Preparatory Courses:

- ◇ Econ 1101 or 1101H (or equivalent)
- ◇ Econ 1102 or 1102H (or equivalent)
- ◇ Math 1271 (or equivalent)

Minor Requirements:

- ◇ Econ 3101 (Intermediate Microeconomics)
- ◇ Econ 3501 or 4531 (Labor Economics)
- ◇ Econ 3601 or 4631 (Industrial Organization and Antitrust Policy)
- ◇ Econ 3801 or 4821 (Public Finance) or 4831 (Cost-Benefit Analysis)
- ◇ One additional Economics major course

Note: In addition to the above courses, we recommend Economics 4211 (Principles of Econometrics).

No substitutions are permitted for the minor requirement. However the preparatory courses can be transferred. This policy is strictly enforced.

All courses for the minor must be taken on the A-F grading system.

A grade of C- or better is required in all courses in the minor.

Only one country/area study course will count towards the requirements.
