Required Preparatory Courses:

- ◇ Econ 1101 or 1101H (or equivalent)
- ◇ Econ 1102 or 1102H (or equivalent)
- ◇ Math 1142 or 1271 (or equivalent)

Minor Requirements:

- ◇ Statistics 3011 (or equivalent) (Statistical Analysis I)
- ◇ Econ 3101 (Intermediate Microeconomics)
- ◇ Econ 3102 (Intermediate Macroeconomics)
- ◇ Econ 4751 (Financial Economics)
- ◇ Econ 3701 or 4721 (Money and Banking)
- ◇ Econ 4731 or 4741 (Macroeconomic Policy or Quantitative Analysis of the Macroeconomy)

No substitutions are permitted for the minor requirement. However the preparatory courses can be transferred. This policy is strictly enforced.

All courses for the minor must be taken on the A-F grading system.

A grade of C- or better is required in all courses in the minor.

Only one country/area study course will count towards the requirements.
